En el siguiente cuadro podrás observar sus diferencias: Cuantificador Ejemplo Much: mucha/oi dont have much money. / No tengo mucho dinero. Many: muchas/osi wont buy many books. / No comprar muchos libros. A lot of: mucha/o y muchas/osi have a lot of money. / Tengo mucho dinero. Ill buy a lot of books. / Comprar muchos libros. Mira el video: La diferencia bsica entre much y many es que much se usa con sustantivos incontables y many con sustantivos contables (tal vez te interese informarte sobre los countable y los uncountable nouns). Ahora explicaremos con ms detalles: Much se utiliza con sustantivos incontables (los cuales no se pueden contar) y suele aparecer en oraciones negativas e interrogativas. Significa mucho o mucha. Oraciones con much en forma negativa: She doesnt have much time because she has 3 children. / Ella no tiene mucho tiempo porque tiene 3 hijos. They havent had much work at the office since October. / Ellos no han tenido mucho trabajo en la oficina desde octubre. I wont need much sugar for the recipe. / No necesitar mucha azcar para la receta. Frases interrogativas: Do you have much homework to do today? / Tienes mucha tarea que hacer hoy? Does he have much paperwork to do at the office? / l tiene mucho papeleo que hacer en la oficina? Did Sam buy much salt in the supermarket? / Sam compr mucha sal en el supermercado? Many se usa con sustantivos contables (los cuales se pueden contar) y se emplea en oraciones negativas e interrogativas. Significa muchos o muchas. Ejemplos con many en negativo: I am not going to need many chairs for the meeting. / No voy a necesitar muchas sillas para la reunin. There arent many tomatoes in the fridge. / No hay muchos tomates en el refrigerador. He didnt have many jobs when he was young. / l no tuvo muchos trabajos cuando era joven. Preguntas: Is he going to need many balloons for the party? / l va a necesitar muchos globos para la fiesta? Have you stayed at many 5-star hotels? / Te has hospedado en muchos hoteles de 5 estrellas? Are there many beds at the beach house? / Hay muchas camas en la casa de la playa? Este tema se puede confundir con las expresiones Too much y Too many. A lot of se utiliza principalmente en oraciones afirmativas (aunque es posible que se use en negaciones y preguntas) con sustantivos contables e incontables. Puede significar muchos, muchas, mucho o mucha: She has a lot of pencils in her backpack. / Ella tiene muchos lpices en su mochila. We have a lot of beds in our house. / Tenemos muchas camas en nuestra casa. Daryl has a lot of free time. / Daryl tiene mucho tiempo libre. I buy a lot of water because I work out every day. / Compr mucha agua porque hago ejercicio todos los das. Aclaraciones importantes: Si bien la recomendacin gramatical es usar a lot of en oraciones afirmativas en lugar de much o many, en el discurso cotidiano la gramtica pura a menudo se reevala.
