The objectives of AnyROR Gujarat include easy accessibility, digitalisation of land records, transparency, fraud prevention, saving citizens' time and effort, record verification, and minimising disputes. To check records on the website, users need to follow these steps: 1. Login to the official website at 2. Select the relevant option (Land Record Rural, Land Record Urban, or Property Search) based on search criteria. 3. Fill in the required details, such as old scanned VF-7 12 details, known khata by owner name, and entry list by month-year. 4. Select one option as per search criteria and fill all required details. The Digitally Sealed Nakal of Property Card Gujarat Land Records Portal offers citizens digital land records. This platform has reduced processing time and increased transparency. To check Any RoR district, go to the official site click on "View land Record-Rural", select options as per requirement, enter land details like District, Talukas, village, survey number/Khata number, Nondh number etc., and verify CAPTCHA code. Now you can check Any RoR district from following: VF7, VF 8A, VF 6, VF 12, e-chavdi, Old scenned 7/12, 135D Notice for mutation, New survey no., From old for promulgated Village, entry list by month and year, integrated survey no. Details, Revenue case details, know khata by owner name, know survey no. Details by UPIN. The AnyRoR website has successfully established in 276 talukas(According to RoR@Anywhere's website as on December2021) and 33 districts. At e-Dhara Center at Taluka Level, you can access various resources related to mutation and land records. The 135-D Notice for Mutation is available here, along with a copy of the notice generated by the Deputy Mamlatdar when you applied for mutation. To obtain a new survey number from an old one for a promoted village, follow these steps: - Get the old survey number. - Use it to get the new survey number. You can also find: - Complete information about the survey number using this option. - Information related to revenue cases by viewing this option. - Account numbers of land owners through this option. - Survey numbers known through UPIN with this option.
