They can't call you, if you don't have the details. It's about how well you present yourself through words.When writing a cover letter, the first paragraph is the introductory paragraph. No because the company wants to get to know who they're going to hire better, and yes because they want to see how you think. This is important because if you exceed this then it will be hard for someone to read quickly and some people might just skip it altogether. However, if they are specifically looking for someone with this skill then include it in your letter and make sure that whoever is reading the letter understands this.How long should a cover letter be?A cover letter should be four paragraphs with a maximum of three to four sentences per paragraph. The second type is more about selling yourself as someone who has the skills that they are looking for and therefore will be suited for the job.If you want to emphasize your skills and show that you know what they are looking for then try using a format that shows them that you are well-read.
