Google contacts android to iphone

Scroll down to "Contacts." Next, select "Accounts." If you didn't add your Google account here already, tap "Add Account." (If you have added it, tap the name of your Google account and skip the next step.) Now, we can select "Google" from the list of services. Concerned about your iPhone's security? Or you can try exporting contacts individually, but that would be tedious. Just make sure that your iPhone model is able to accept the type of SIM you wish to use, as compatibility may vary. You can email it to yourself, upload it to a cloud storage service such as Google Drive, or send it over Bluetooth. Switching from Android to iPhone isn't as difficult as it seems, but you probably have a contact list that's been curated for years. Such people can transfer their contacts via creating a VCF file and sharing it over email or SMS.1. Open the Contacts app on your Android.2.
